The trail would be approximately 1.2 miles long. The trail concept is supported by the Cumberland Township Supervisors and the Straban Township Rec Board. The trail would be 6-10 feet wide.

UNKNOWNNS


It's unclear on which side of the road the trail would be built. A study will likely be needed to evaluate the pros & cons for each side. In any event, the trail can only be built with the permission from the appropriate property owners. Use of "eminent domain" is NOT an option. Ideally, the new trail would link to the existing North Gettysburg Trail at the High School. Exactly how and where is yet to be determined.

CHALLENGES

The trail will need to cross several creeks along the way. There may be other wetlands issues as well. HABPI will need to pursue grant funding for the design and construction of the trail.

Boyd School Road Trail Concept

We're interested in what you think. Healthy Adams Bicycle/Pedestrian, Inc (HABPI) is a non-profit organization whose mission is to develop walking and bicycling trails in Adams County. We are currently exploring the concept of a trail alongside of Boyd School Road from the Gettysburg High School campus to Biglerville Rd (Rt 34). We'd like to know your thoughts and concerns.



The new trail would link to the existing North Gettysburg Trail which runs between Gettysburg High School and the borough of Gettysburg. Several key businesses, organizations, and communities would have direct access to the Boyd School Trail including the Adams County offices, St. Francis Xavier, Gettysburg Place Apartments and the Gettysburg High School. The Patriots Choice community, located on the west side of Biglerville Rd, could also readily access the trail.

The trail would provide a safe walking and biking path between these locations and, with the connection to the North Gettysburg Trail, a route all the way into Gettysburg. So, as an example, a student at the Gettysburg Place apartments could safely travel to the High School by bike or on foot. And a county employee who lives in Gettysburg could bike to the offices using the new trail and the North Gettysburg Trail.
